

Early Transfer Identification Program E-TIP







The purpose is to provide an Early Transfer Identification Program and related services to TCCD students who transfer to UTA.

- First time in college
- Enrolling in either AA or AS degree plans





Primary benefit for students is to lock in the tuition rate with UTA on the day that the student applies to TCCD for 48 months.



Each semester an electronic file is generated by TCCD and sent to UTA containing designated data elements with which to create an application record.





A UTA admissions representative meets with students in the Transfer Center located on the TCCD campus or other designated space.





UTA provides transfer workshops for students participating in E-TIP on a semester basis.

TRANSFER UTA



UTA provides a data file each semester to TCCD of students who are participating in the E-TIP for Reverse Articulation to ensure completion of the Associate's Degree.
